Tips for a Stellar Tacony Admissions Presentation!

T: Talk slowly - Nervous and inexperienced speakers tend to talk way to fast. Consciously slow your speech down and add pauses for emphasis. Take your time; what you have to say is important.

A: Appearance – Appearance is important. Dressing in business or professional attire is a must. Not only is it what people will expect when interviewing for your future career, it has been discovered that dressing up positively affects your mood.

C: Creativity – Be Creative! Tacony Academy Charter Prep is geared towards innovative thinking. Creativity keeps your audience engaged and also helps your audience retain information.

O: One Shot – Unfortunately, sometimes you get ONE shot to show what you are made of. Make the best out of the opportunity. Your 5-7 minutes is one chance to show that you are serious about the work you do and you take pride in the effort. Research your topic. Be prepared to answer questions comfortably. Be confident in your work.

N: Never come late – “Being on time is being late.” Please allow yourself ample time to get to your location. Allow extra time in the event of an emergency. Never come late to an appointment or interview without calling unless something happens out of your control.

Y: Yes, you can do it! Practice makes perfect. – Oftentimes presenters rely on note cards and reading word for word off of their power point slides. Practice your presentation so you can deliver it with confidence and only refer to notes if you need to. It is less about memorization than it is about knowing your topic.
